

**Pemberville Village Joint Cemetery Meeting
5/20/03**

The Annual Joint Cemetery Meeting was called to order at 8:10 p.m. on Tuesday, May 20th, 2003 by Cemetery Board President, James Witker.

Present for roll call were Mayor Oberhouse, Witker, Avers, Vandersall, Panning, Sharp, Wegman, Brann and Mazur.

Minutes for 2002 were reviewed and approved as submitted.

The financial statement for 2002 was presented. It showed receipts for 2002 were \$10,723.31 and expenses \$12,159.87. Balance on hand December 31, 2002 was \$6,288.30. Wegman moved, seconded by Brann, to accept the financial statement. The motion carried unanimously.

Finances stayed pretty even since the prices of lots and grave openings were raised.

A small excavator was rented to help the Sextant dig for foundations instead of doing it by hand.

The Township is still doing work at the cemetery on a reimbursement basis, which seems to be working well.

Witker's term will end December 31, 2003 and someone from Council will be needed to fill that vacancy.

Wegman nominated Brann for a 3-year term as Cemetery Trustee to go into effect January 1, 2004. Sharp seconded the nomination. Sharp moved that nominations be closed. Seconded by Avers, the motion carried unanimously.

Vandersall moved at 8:20 p.m. to adjourn the Annual Joint Cemetery Meeting. Wegman seconded the motion, which carried unanimously.
