

The Special Joint Meeting of Pemberville Village Council and Board of Public Affairs was called to order by Mayor Opelt on Monday, May 2, 2005 at 7:00 p.m. The special meeting was advertised as required by the Sunshine Law.

Present for roll call were Panning, Sharp, Brann, Donaldson, Aring, Schulte and Busdeker. Vandersall and Barnes were absent.

The meeting was held as a brainstorming session for ways to save money for the Village.

Some of the suggestions and comments were: change to lower cell phone plan—give so many minutes, take a look at gasoline expenditures, shut vehicles off, fix old police car instead of purchasing a new one, only one police car, figure out a way to pay for Spring Cleanup, stop heating old street garage in the winter, charge for brush and leaf pickup, provide a place for residents to take brush and grass clippings, be diligent with utilities at the pool, move cars off streets for street sweeping to get a better job, no workshops, employees pay more for benefits, no travel, employees used to clean around catch basins on a regular basis which saved on contract cleaning costs, are we recouping Personnel Supervisor salary in additional work or service.

It was decided to ask each employee to submit ideas on how they can save money and meet again June 6 at 7:00 p.m.

The joint meeting adjourned at 8:55 p.m.
