COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE
JANUARY 20, 2009

The Committee of the Whole was called to order at 7 pm.

The following Shovel-Ready Projects were discussed:

The Fire Department would like a circle of waterlines in the Martin Street and Joyce Ave. area to improve the water pressure for the Fire Department. There has been very low pressure which has been a concern for a long time. Miesmer said there are maps that could be taken to Feller and Finch to get an estimate of this work.

The new Waste Water Treatment Plant is planned to begin construction by July 1, 2009.

The Village is in need of a new Water Tower.

The old Ford Garage could be replaced with a new community building.

Utility lines in the downtown business alley and on Pine and Cedar Streets needed to be replaced.

Utility lines for Perry Street are needed because of low water pressure

An entire new water line system within the Village is really needed since the current lines were put in around 1938.

Downtown Catch Basins needed to be replaced and could be done in conjunction with the future street scape project.

The street scape project.

Water meter replacement project.

Removal of all interconnections that remain between the Sanitary and Storm system grid Sluice Valves, Overflow Valves, Bypass Valves.

Mayor Opelt asked the BPA and Fire Chief Martin to meet with Council on February 3, 2009 at 7 pm to continue this discussion.
