

**VILLAGE OF PEMBERVILLE  
COUNCIL MEETING  
JULY 6, 2010**

Mayor Opelt opened the July 6, 2010 meeting at 7:14pm with a prayer and led those present in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll Call: Present at the regular meeting of council were Bockbrader, Campbell, Cox, and Fuerst. Absent were Bowman and King.  
Others present were Andrew Venier, Ed Wozniak, and Howard Shirling.

**Minutes:** Cox moved and Bockbrader seconded to approve the June 15, 2010 minutes as presented. The motion passed unanimously.

**Treasurer's Report:**

Campbell made a motion to approve payment of bills in the amount of \$6,509.76 and Bockbrader seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

**Mayor:**

The Mayor explained there is a Certified Public Records Training available on Friday, October 22 from 1pm-4:15pm at Owens Community College. This training is required for all Public Officials one time per term. The clerk asked that everyone inform her if they were going by mid August so that she could register everyone.

The Mayor explained he received a request asking Council to review the current ordinance dealing with animals within the Village.

There is a Car Show on Thursday, July 8.

Chief Darling distributed the police department activity report.

Fuerst question if the Police Bicycle has been repaired. It has not been addressed yet. Chief Darling explained a Police Officer is required to obtain special certification to ride the bike. The cost to do this is very high. Fuerst asked how many Police Officers the Village employs. The Mayor explained it does not matter the number of part time employees because the Village is only covering a set number of hours each day. The Mayor prefers to have additional part time employees because this allows for coverage if a part time employee would obtain a full time position elsewhere.
