

**VILLAGE OF PEMBERVILLE
COUNCIL MEETING
September 7, 2010**

Council President Bowman opened the September 7, 2010 meeting at 7:00pm with a prayer and led those present in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll Call: Present at the regular meeting of council was Bowman, Bockbrader, Campbell, Cox, and King. Absent were Mayor Opelt and Fuerst
Others present were Howard Shirling, Brad Bowe, Ed Wozniak, Gene Steele, Joe Montag, and the clerk.

Minutes: King moved and Cox seconded to approve the August 17, 2010 minutes as presented. The motion passed unanimously.

Treasurer's Report:

Cox made a motion to approve payment of bills in the amount of \$3422.30 and King seconded. The motion passed unanimously.
