

**VILLAGE OF PEMBERVILLE  
COUNCIL MEETING  
February 21, 2012**

Mayor Bowman opened the February 21, 2012 meeting at 7:00pm with a prayer and led those present in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll Call: Present at the regular meeting of council were Campbell, Bockbrader, Cox, Fuerst, Rothenbuhler, and Schuerman. Others present were Doug Wegman, Vic Schuerman, Joanne Busdeker, Gene Steele, Mary Cowell, and the clerk.

**Minutes:** Rothenbuhler moved and Schuerman seconded to approve the February 7, 2012 minutes as presented. The motion passed unanimously.

**Treasurer's Report:** Cox made a motion to approve payment of bills in the amount of \$2,584.53 and Campbell seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

Rothenbuhler moved and Fuerst seconded to pass Ordinance 1498. The motion passed unanimously.

**Mayor Bowman:**

The Police report for 2/7/12 – 2/21/12 was distributed.

Mayor Bowman explained the Wood County Commissioners responded to the village's request for a Town Hall meeting. It is tentatively scheduled for April 18, 2012.

Mayor Bowman explained the Ohio Plan is hosting a seminar on March 2, 2012. The topic will be liability for elected officials. There is no cost. If anyone would like to attend, please contact Stephanie.

The Wood County Economic Development Commission will be hosting their annual dinner on March 21, 2012. The cost is \$40 per person.

**Rothenbuhler:**

Planning Commission will meet tomorrow, February 22.

**Schuerman:**

Flores and Miller have agreed to return for the 2012 pool season at the same rate as last year. The Park and Recreation Committee recommended hiring Flores for \$3,750 and Miller for \$575. Schuerman moved and Bockbrader seconded to hire Flores as pool manager at a

rate of \$3,750 for the 2012 season. The motion passed unanimously. Schuerman moved and Cox seconded to hire Miller as Swim Team coach at a rate of \$575 for the 2012 season.

**Other:**

Property clean up was discussed. Properties at 810 West Front Street, 828 West Front Street, and 115 Cherry Street were discussed. Mayor Bowman will contact property owners to determine if they will comply with a request to clean up their property.

Canine etiquette was discussed. Dogs are required to be on a leash and residents are reminded to clean up after their animals.

There has been a car parked at 355 East Front Street for some time. The owner will be contacted. The village is still having issues with residents using village dumpsters for personal use. This is being addressed by the police.

Doug Wegman suggested that the village consider addressing sidewalks and curb appeal to assist in attracting businesses.

It was noted that the website needs to be updated with new council members and committee members and also including a link for new resident information.

Mayor Bowman adjourned the meeting at 8:15pm.
