**ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1 OF ORDINANCE NUMBER 1065,  
RELATING TO A CURFEW FOR MINORS 16 YEARS AND YOUNGER**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PEMBERVILLE, COUNTY OF WOOD, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: That Section 1 of Ordinance Number 1065 is hereby amended and adopted as follows:

SECTION 1: It shall be unlawful for any person 16 years of age or under to be or remain upon any street or alley or other public place in the Village after 11:00 p.m. on Sunday evening through Thursday evening, or after 12:00 p.m. on Friday evening or Saturday evening, unless such person is accompanied by a parent or guardian, or other person having custody of such minor, or unless in the performance of duty directed by such parent or guardian or other person having custody, or unless such person is in lawful employment, or on a lawful errand, making it necessary to be in such places after said hours.

SECTION 2: This ordinance shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.
