ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A STORM SEWER MANAGEMENT AND OPERATIONS FEE AND PROVIDING FOR THE SUPERVISION AND MANAGEMENT OF STORM SEWERS IN THE VILLAGE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PEMBERVILLE, COUNTY OF WOOD, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: That the Board of Public Affairs shall manage and supervise all operations with respect to storm sewers including, but not limited to, the maintenance and upkeep of existing storm sewers within the Village.

SECTION 2: A storm sewer maintenance and operations fee of \$3.00 per water meter served by the Village Water System is hereby established for purposes of maintaining, repairing, and/or replacing the storm sewer system in the Village, which fees shall be deposited to the Storm Sewer Enterprise Fund as collected, and disbursed for storm sewer maintenance and repair and replacement as determined from time to time by the Board of Public Affairs.

SECTION 3: This ordinance shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.
