

**ORDINANCE REQUIRING APPROVAL FOR LOCATION OF POSTINGS OR
OTHER IMPROVEMENTS ON VILLAGE PROPERTY AND/OR VILLAGE
RIGHT OF WAY**

Subtitle: Required Approval for placement of a sign, posting, improvement, mail receptacle or other obstruction on Village property or Village right of way.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PEMBERVILLE, COUNTY OF WOOD, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: No person shall construct any sign, posting, improvement, mail receptacle, or other obstruction on Village property or upon Village right of way without prior approval of Village Council.

SECTION 2: Whoever violates this Section shall be guilty of a minor misdemeanour.

SECTION 3: This ordinance shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.
