**ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBER 1146 CONCERNING
SIDEWALK REPAIRS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

Subtitle: Ordinance amending ordinance #1146. This ordinance increases the reimbursement amounts to residents for sidewalk repairs.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PEMBERVILLE, COUNTY OF WOOD, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: That Ordinance Number 1146 passed on September 15, 1998, and amended December 5, 2006, at Section I therein, is hereby amended and adopted by substitution as follows:

SECTION 1: All property owners who replace their sidewalks in whole or in part, shall be entitled to reimbursement from the Village of Pemberville for a portion of the cost of such replacement, which portion shall be \$1.00 per square foot at a depth of four (4) inches and \$1.25 per square foot at a depth of six (6) inches for each square foot of sidewalk replaced. All property owners shall be entitled to reimbursement from the Village of Pemberville for sidewalks leveled by the process of "MUD JACKING" done by professional means and to the satisfaction of the Village of Pemberville, which portion shall be 25% of the leveling cost.

SECTION 2: This ordinance shall take effect as an emergency measure. The reason for the emergency is that the prompt effectiveness of this measure is necessary in order to make sidewalk repairs in the Village prior to the winter season, and thereby preserve the public health, safety and well being of our citizens.
