**ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE
A CONTRACT FOR EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT BETWEEN
WOOD COUNTY, OHIO, AND THE VILLAGE OF PEMBERVILLE,
FOR CALENDAR YEARS 2008 AND 2009
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PEMBERVILLE,
COUNTY OF WOOD, AND STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: That the Mayor is authorized to execute a contract with Wood County, Ohio, for emergency management for calendar years 2008 and 2009 in substantial accordance with the exhibit attached hereto and made a part hereof.

SECTION 2: This ordinance shall take effect as an emergency measure. The reason for the emergency is that the prompt effectiveness of this measure is necessary so as to put in place all necessary documentation for the continued furnishing of emergency management by Wood County, Ohio, as there was a delay in the preparation of 2008 documents, only now received by the Village, and a contract for calendar year 2008 is immediately necessary in order to protect the public health, safety and well being of our citizens.
