ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF A NEW POLICE CRUISER, INCLUDING EQUIPMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PEMBERVILLE, COUNTY OF WOOD, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: That the Fiscal Officer is authorized to purchase on behalf of the Village a new police cruiser and including new equipment in substantial accordance with the exhibit attached hereto and made a part hereof, without advertising for bids, but instead to purchase at the state bid price.

SECTION 2: This ordinance shall take effect as an emergency measure. The reason for the emergency is the prompt effectiveness of this measure is necessary in order to have appropriate systems in place for the Village Police Department transportation needs and immediate action is necessary in order to protect the public health, safety and well being of our citizens.
