**ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1 OF ORDINANCE NUMBER 1065,
RELATING TO A CURFEW FOR CERTAIN MINORS**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PEMBERVILLE, COUNTY OF WOOD, AND STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: That Section 1 of Ordinance Number 1065, as amended by Ordinance Number 1358, is hereby amended and adopted as follows:

Section 1: CURFEW:

- (A) No juvenile fifteen (15) years of age or younger, shall remain in or upon any public place or any establishment between 10:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. of the following day, municipal time, except that on Friday and Saturday nights, the hours shall be from 11:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m. of the following day.
- (B) No juvenile, sixteen (16) and seventeen (17) years of age, shall remain in or upon a public place or any establishment between 11:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. of the following day, municipal time, except that on Friday and Saturday nights, the hours shall be from 12:00 midnight to 6:00 a.m. the following day.
- (C) This section shall not apply to any juvenile who is accompanied by his/her parent, guardian or sibling older than 21 years of age. This section does not apply to any juvenile with a writing carried on his or her person, is carrying out any errand or other legitimate business pursuant to written directions of a parent, guardian or adult person in charge of that juvenile, nor to any juvenile engaged in lawful, gainful employment during the curfew hours.

SECTION 2: This ordinance shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.
