ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND FISCAL OFFICER TO EXTEND THE CONTRACT WITH BUCKEYE SANITATION, INC., FOR TRASH REMOVAL IN THE VILLAGE OF PEMBERVILLE

PASSED: January 2, 2008

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PEMBERVILLE, COUNTY OF WOOD, AND STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: That the Mayor and Fiscal Officer are authorized and directed to enter into an extension of the contract authorized by Ordinance Number 1379 passed December 19, 2006, with Buckeye Sanitation, Inc. Said extension is authorized for an additional three (3) years beginning January 1, 2008, and ending on the last day of December, 2010. Said extension shall include an adjustment to charges as follows: Village customers shall pay the contractor for the service the sum of \$27.50 per quarter, with a 5 container limit per week; or tags will be sold for \$12.50 per 10 packs (\$1.25 each). Said charges shall remain in effect for the entire calendar year 2008. Charges for calendar years 2009 and 2010 shall be mutually agreed between Village Council and Buckeye Sanitation, Inc., and in the event a mutually agreed upon charge cannot be reached for either or both years, then the extension and the contract shall be terminated.

SECTION 2: In all other respects Ordinance Number 1379 shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3: This ordinance shall take effect as an emergency measure. The reason for the emergency is the prompt effectiveness of this measure is necessary as the current contract for trash removal from the Village and for Village residents will expire on December 31, 2007, and accordingly, this ordinance is necessary in order to maintain and continue trash hauling services for Village residents without interruption, and thereby protect the public health, safety and well being of our citizens.
