**ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND FISCAL OFFICER TO ENTER
INTO A CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS WITH THE OHIO PLAN FOR
INSURANCE COVERAGE FOR THE VILLAGE OF PEMBERVILLE, AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF
PEMBERVILLE, COUNTY OF WOOD, AND STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: That the Mayor and Fiscal Officer are authorized and directed to enter into a contract or contracts with the Ohio Plan for insurance coverage for the Village for the period August 1, 2008 through July 31, 2009, and/or for the period August 1, 2009 through July 31, 2010.

SECTION 3: This ordinance shall take effect as an emergency measure. The reason for the emergency is the prompt effectiveness of this measure is necessary as the current contract for insurance will expire on August 1, 2008, and accordingly, this ordinance is necessary in order to maintain and continue insurance coverage for Village without interruption, and thereby protect the public health, safety and well being of our citizens.
