

RESOLUTION DETERMINING TO SUBMIT TO THE ELECTORS OF THE VILLAGE OF PEMBERVILLE THE QUESTION OF AN ADDITIONAL TAX IN EXCESS OF THE 10 MIL LIMITATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING POLICE PROTECTION FUNDS FOR THE VILLAGE OF PEMBERVILLE.

WHEREAS, Council for the Village of Pemberville has determined that it would be in the best interest of the citizens of the Village to approve a 2.7 mill levy for Police Protection purposes for five (5) years for the purposes of paying for such expenses of the Village of Pemberville pursuant to Revised Code Section 5705.19, by adoption of Resolution Number 702, on August 29, 2008.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PEMBERVILLE, COUNTY OF WOOD, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: That for the purpose of providing additional funds for Police Protection expenditures for the Village of Pemberville, it is necessary to approve a new tax of 2.7 mills; that it is necessary to levy said tax outside of the limitations imposed by Section 2, Article XII of the Ohio Constitution; that said additional tax request shall be submitted to the electors of the Village of Pemberville at the General Election to be held on the first Tuesday of November, 2008, in order that said tax levy shall be placed on the duplicate effective January 1, 2008, to be collected on and after January 1, 2009, and thereafter for a total of five years.

SECTION 2: That the Clerk of the Village is hereby directed to certify a copy of this Resolution to the Auditor of Wood County, who shall calculate the amount of money said 2.7 mill Police Protection levy will produce, and said Auditor shall certify said calculation to the legislative authority, all as required by Ohio Revised Code Section 5705.03(B).

SECTION 4: That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
